But the Lord himself went before us, and He has never left us nor forsaken us or the work to which He's called us. Those are His promises, and we stand on them firmly because we can believe the promises of the God who is the same yesterday, today, and tomorrow.

When we look at our sweet students, how can we feel afraid? We see their boldness and courage; we see the promises that God has made to us and know that those promises are for our little students, too. We know that His promises are for the mothers and young people in our Bible studies, for the families for whom we help provide safe housing, for a small mountainside in El Salvador from which we want to hear "His praises ring."

**You are part of that promise.** When God called us to this work, He graciously went before us and prepared the way. We've seen His provision in your gifts to this work. Thank you for being a part of His promise.

Watching his family become part of the community has been a beautiful thing. They play soccer together. Daniel's mom comes to Bible study. His dad, mom, and big sister all pitched in to help when our shipping container arrived this summer, while Daniel made sure little brother was entertained.

But, the best part of this family becoming a part of our little Salvadoran community is that, this summer, Daniel's mom, dad, and big sister all became part of a bigger community—the family of God. We're grateful for the small part we've had in pointing families like Daniel's to the One who gave us this work.

That number doesn't seem very impressive, but, for us, **two** was a big deal. That number meant that, of our 157 current sponsorSHIP students, only two students were completely unsponsored.

We hope to find sponsors for those two students and for the 15 students who'll be starting school with us in January 2024, but we're just overjoyed that so many of our students are sponsored.

We started our sponsorSHIP program with the words of Jeremiah 29:11 in mind:

"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." We wanted our students to know that God cared for them and would provide for them.

Being a sponsor means so much more than giving money. It means that a little girl or boy who may not have any close family actively being the hands and feet of Jesus in his or her life now has someone showing the love of Christ.
